

Campground Rules

For your comfort and safety, everyone staying at or visiting our Campground must follow the rules below.

Vehicles

1. All vehicles that enter the campground must be registered, display registration plates, have compulsory third party insurance and be driven by a licenced driver. The use and/or storage of any unregistered motorised vehicle is prohibited within the campground.
2. Trespassing vehicles will be reported to the police.
3. Pedestrians have right of way at all times. In the interest of safety, the speed limit throughout the campground must not exceed 8 kilometres per hour.
4. All vehicles must be parked within site boundaries or on designated parking areas at all times.
5. The washing of vehicles, boats or trailers is not permitted within the campground.
6. A **vehicle pass** must be displayed on the dashboard on your car at all times whilst parked on your site.

Caravan and camp sites

7. Caravans, tents and alike must be erected within the boundaries of the caravan and camping site designated by Campground Management and be kept at least 2.5 meters from any other moveable dwelling or structure & 50cm from the site boundary. Caravan draw bars must be set up to face the access road for easy removal in case of emergency.
8. Caravans are not permitted to stay on Camp Sites, only on Short Term sites and no more than one caravan or moveable dwelling is permitted on a site at a time.
9. Guests occupying powered sites are entitled to use only one power outlet per site booked. Only one continuous and uninterrupted 15 amp lead may be connected from the Campground's electrical supply outlets to a movable dwelling. The use of splitting devices and multiple adaptors is prohibited.
10. Movable dwellings on serviced sites must be connected to a sullage point at all times. Grey water must not be allowed to run onto the road or sites.
11. The use of additional ground sheets made of cloth or open weave material is permitted. Guests using tarps or any other such ground cover will be required to move sites or remove tarps.
12. The guest must maintain the site in a clean & tidy condition and free from all garbage, refuse & waste matter.

Dogs and animals

13. Animals are not allowed at any time unless they are certified assistance animals.

Visitors

14. All visitors must be registered with the Campground Management before entering.
15. Before 10:00pm, no more than four (4) day visitors are permitted on site free of charge otherwise day use charges shall apply.

16. All day visitors must leave the campground before 10:00pm, unless they have made an overnight booking with campground reception or paid the applicable day use charge with the approval of Campground management.
17. Visitors' vehicles must be parked outside the campground unless additional parking has been arranged with Campground management and fees paid.

Bikes, scooters, and skateboards

18. Helmets must be worn at all times when using bicycles, scooters, skateboards, rollerblades and alike.
19. Riding after dusk is not permitted within the campground.
20. Bikes, scooters, and skateboards are not to be ridden in or around the immediate vicinity of the Campground's amenity blocks, camp kitchen or reception.

Garbage

21. Guests and their visitors must ensure all garbage and waste is securely placed in appropriate receptacles.
22. The disposal of any items not considered general household waste is strictly prohibited at the park.

Noise and behaviour

23. Guests must vacate all common areas of the campground before 10:00pm and contain noise to a reasonable level so as not to impact any other person.
24. Guests must not cause or permit any noise between 12:00am and 7:00am
25. Generators are NOT permitted on the Camping Reserve.
26. No open or wood fires on the sites or on the beach. No solid fuel such as charcoal barbeques or rotisseries are permitted.
27. All children under the age of 18 are to be supervised by an adult at all times.

Amenities

28. No body or Surf boards are to be taken into the amenities.
29. Wet suits are not to be worn into the amenities & all sand is to be removed at the outdoor beachside showers prior to entry.
30. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult whilst using the amenities.

Length of stay

31. Please see the Booking Terms page for details of minimum and maximum lengths of stay.

Park property

32. Guests and/or their visitors must not intentionally or negligently cause or permit damage or destruction to a site or any park property.
33. Guests will be held liable for the costs associated with the repair, replacement or rectification of any damage caused.

Eviction

34. Campground management reserves the right to remove any guests and/or their visitors from the Campground if they breach any law, agreement, or Park rule and/or they are charged by the Police for committing an offence and will not be permitted re-enter the tourist park unless accompanied by Police.
